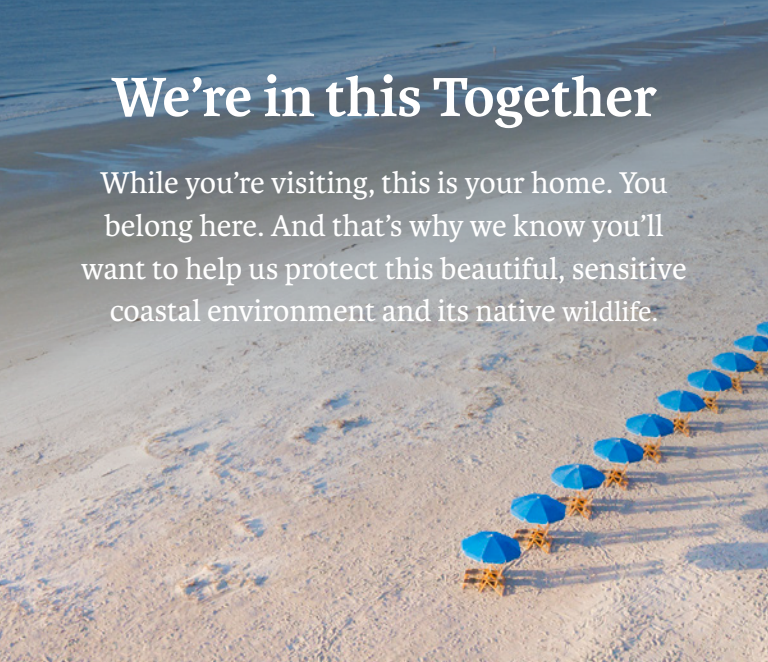


We're in this Together

Staying Safe Together

The Hilton Head Island-Bluffton Chamber of Commerce, in partnership with the business community, town governments and residents, established the Path Forward Readiness Plan. This plan includes best practice protocols designed to help reduce the risk of virus transmission.

You can support these safety measures by following these CDC recommendations:



Maintain a minimum 6-foot distance from others in public spaces and local businesses.



Wash your hands regularly or use a hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol.



Wear a face mask for the safety of yourself and others.



Sneeze or cough into a tissue, cloth, or your elbow.
